



# Cliffs Of Moher/ Aran Islands

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# Information

The Cliffs Of Moher and Aran Islands are surrounded by the Atlantic Ocean. Storms do affect the coast, but not so much in the inland. Storms are worst in The Aran Islands than Ireland because of The Aran Islands having way less land around it. For example, The biggest island of The Aran Islands (Inis Mór) only measures 12 km in length and 3 km in width. Where as Ireland measures 436 km long - 424 km longer than Inis Mór.

The Cliffs Of Moher measures 702 feet tall and 14 km long. There is a walk along the Cliffs Of Moher which measures around 20 km long.

# Amenities

On the biggest island, Inis Mór, there is a Supermacs. This is by far the most popular destination on Inis Mór.


On all islands there are stalls, where you can purchase all types of food. Ranging from chocolate to fish.




## Contrast to where I live:
